GENERAL RULES

- No outsider is allowed to enter the college premises without a valid reason.
- All students have to be in specified uniform as shown below:
Girls: white uniform comprising kameez, salwar and dupatta with black sweaters (in winters) and white socks with black shoes.
Boys: White Shirt and Black Pant, Black sweater (in winters) and white socks with black shoes.
- Any student if found absent from college without permission for more ten consecutive days shall be terminated from the college rolls.
- Use of Mobile is strictly banned.
- Unlawful assembly of students in the college is prohibited.
- Ragging in any form, on or off the college campus, is a cognizable offence punishable under the Anti Ragging law. This may also include expulsion from the college and rustication.
- Writing of graffiti or sticking of posters and spitting in any way is a cognizable offence punishable under Disaster Management Act and will be fined Rs. 500.
- Use of unfair means in the examinations is violation of University rules and is liable for issuance of bad character certificate.
- A student desirous of withdrawing his/her name from the college roll is required to submit an application, duly countersigned by the parent/guardian. The withdrawal certificate shall be issued after all the college dues are cleared by the student. Such students shall in no case be readmitted during the same academic year.

LIBRARY RULES

- Library card is issued to students at the start of the academic session by the librarian.
- Students can borrow two books from the library at a time as per the given schedule.
- Books are issued for a period of 14 days only after that Re 1/day will be charged.
- Books issued if found damaged or lost in any way shall have to be replaced by the borrower failing which double the cost of the books shall be charged.
- Strict silence shall have to be observed in the library and reading room with no cross talk.

IDENTITY CARDS

- Every student shall regularly bring 'Identity Card' issued by the College. College authorities can check the card anytime, anywhere in the premises.
- The loss of Identity Card shall be reported immediately to the Office and local Police Station.

- However, duplicate identity card after a proper verification may be issued against payment of Rs. 100/-

FACILITIES

Admission Schedule For Semester I

Eligibility Criteria

Admission to B.A/ B.Com Sem-1

Admission to semester –I of the Three year B.A/B.Com course shall be open to a candidate having passed the higher secondary part-II(10+2pattern) examination (in full subjects) of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or an examination recognized as equivalent there to subject to the availability of seats & if otherwise found eligible.

Admission to B.C.A Sem-1

Admission to semester –I of the Three year B.C.A course shall be open to a candidate having passed the higher secondary part-II(10+2pattern) examination (in full subjects) of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics as one of the elective subjects and has obtained at least 50% of aggregate marks in qualifying examination in case of General category candidates and 45% marks in case of SC/ST Candidates.

Subject Combination

The students will opt for the following subjects:

1. Any one of these:
English/Hindi/Urdu/Dogri
2. Any one of these:
Communication English/Hindi/Urdu/Dogri
3. Environmental Science (Compulsory)

Further students will have to opt any of the following combination:

1. Political science, Education
2. Sociology, Education

4. History, Education
5. Economics, Political Science
6. Economics, Sociology
7. Sociology, History
8. Psychology, Political Science
9. Psychology, Education
10. Psychology, Sociology
11. Commerce (B.Com)
